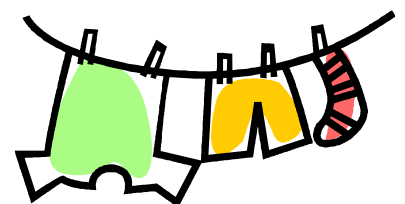
For many childhood illnesses, we are required by the State of Texas to notify the whole class about an illness.
